

## **NISCORT Participates in INDIA TV Show ‘Aap Ki Adalat’**

The students of NISCORT on September 8 participated in the TV show *Aap Ki Adalat* telecast by INDIA TV. Mr Raaj Babbar, actor turned politician and the President of UP Congress was the guest at the show, anchored by Rajat Sharma. Ms Smita Gupta, a senior journalist played the role of the judge at the show, enacted as if in a court.

In the programme, Sharma charged Babbar that he had ditched the film industry and joined politics. Mr Babbar was also criticized for his hot temperament and his use of indecent language. Questioned why he had left the Samajawadi Party (SP) Babbar said “I did not leave them but they removed me”. However, he expressed his gratitude to Mulayam Singh Yadav, the SP Chief for bringing him into politics. “Even today I take Mulayam Singh’s name with respect,” said Babbar.

At the Adalat, Sharma played a short video from the channel’s archives showing Babbar scolding a police officer. In his response Babbar accepted it was a mistake and expressed regret. At the end of the trial Ms Smita passed judgment that Babbar had defended himself well and therefore is absolved of all the charges leveled.
